- Participating in telephone calls with your coach
- Supporting your team in completing their actions

<b>Meeting Schedule</b>
Neighborhood Walk (2 to 3 hours at least 10 days before your Neighborhood Gathering)
Neighborhood Gathering (2 hours. Schedule subsequent meetings approximately every two weeks.)
Water Quality Meeting (1 ½ hours)
Water Conservation Meeting (1 ½ hours)
Helping Out Meeting (1 ½ hours)
Reunion (Optional - approximately 2 months after Helping Out Meeting.)

- Please list vacations for the next three months.
- Please list some possible dates for your neighborhood walk and gathering, with a goal of two dates at least 10 days apart.
